- **General guidance**, including home care support
- **Medical facility recommendations** near your job site or home
- **Information and necessary forms** for the treating facility
- **Injury follow-up** within 1-2 days
- **Proper documentation** of injury
- **Answers to your basic questions** related to your work-related injury

About Workers' Compensation

If you are injured while working or traveling for work, you qualify for workers' compensation.

This means that Purdue will cover approved medical expenses, provide weekly benefits for lost time and offer a one-time payment based on the disability rating assigned by your doctor.
